

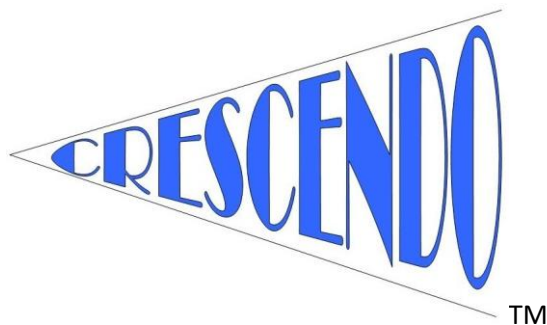

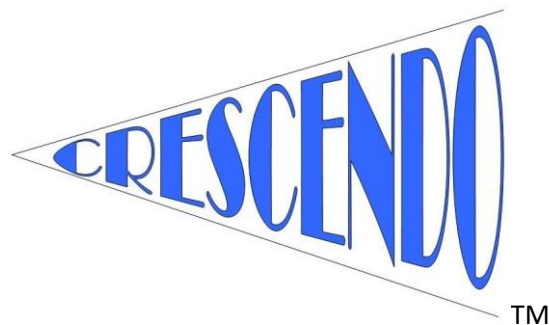

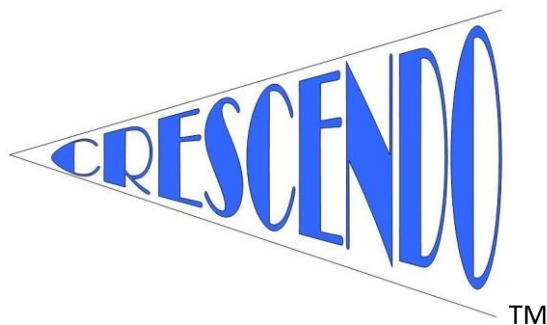
All the scarves are falling down,

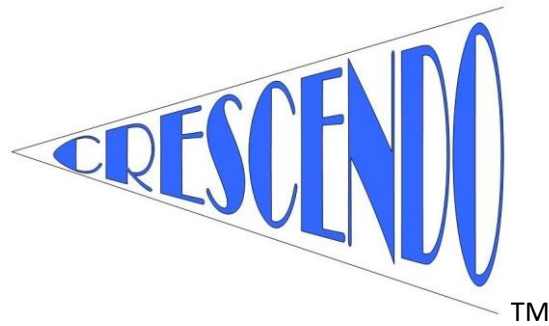

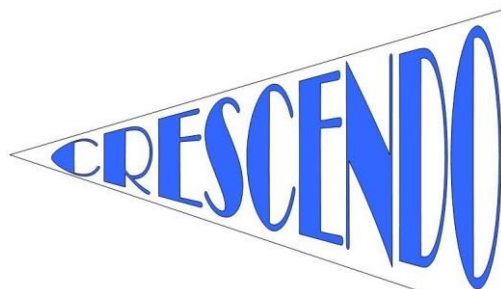

Right leg! *(right leg up and down like marching)*

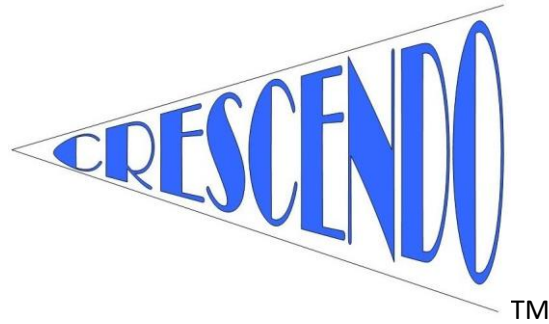
Repeat song
